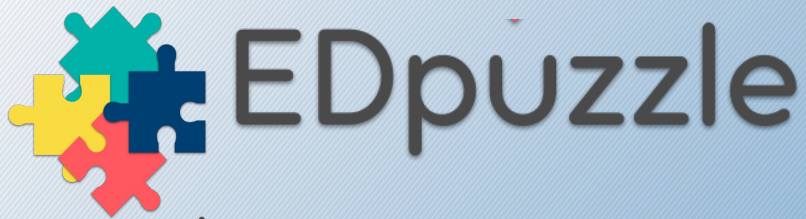

- Free accounts are limited to 22 padlets and have limited features.
- They have a free 30-day trial and then plans start at \$12 per month.
 - Upgrade option is \$8 per month

Description: Learners use this platform to reflect upon, discuss and showcase what they are learning, making, reading, solving, experiencing, and playing. Educators create grids, or meeting places for their classroom. Then they create a Topic to ignite discussion and student responses. This is a creative platform for student to share what they know with their peers and teachers.

Key Features and Benefits

- **Students create short, authentic videos within this platform, or they can upload their own.**
- **It's simple and fun to make these videos. Learners pause and flip their camera while recording, add uploaded photos, trim video clips, add a whiteboard, text, emoji and more.**

- It's completely free and can be used across the subject areas!
 - Ice breakers
 - Exit tickets
 - Book talks
 - STEM demonstrations
- It integrates well with Google Classroom, Canvas, Microsoft Teams & more!
- It has screen-recording and AR features too!
- These videos can be shared with families and they can respond too!

Limitations

- There's a lot to learn with this platform, but they have extensive support and advanced training for educators to receive PD and certificates.
- If students upload their own videos, they have to be under 500MB. This may frustrate some students that prefer other video making software.

Description: Quizlet is a free website providing learning tools for students, including flashcards, study and game modes

Key Features and Benefits

- Flashcards—Review your material, shuffle/randomize, or listen with audio.
- Learn—Track your correct/incorrect answers and retest the ones you've missed.
- Speller—Type what you hear in this audio-powered study mode.
- Test—Randomly generate tests based on your flashcard set.

Wow Factor

- Quizlet Live
- Scatter—Race against the clock to drag and match terms/definitions.
- Space Race—Type in the answer as terms/definitions scroll across the screen
- Search over 1 million existing study sets available and ready to use.

Limitations

- Free accounts come with advertisements
- Free accounts do not allow you to track student progress

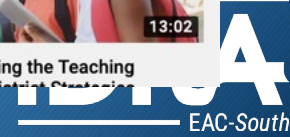
